## **Statutory Declaration for Evidencing on-the-job experience as an Electrical Fitter (For use by an employer/supervisor)**

The Electrical Workers and Contractors Board is responsible for issuing electrical licences to suitably trained and competent persons to carry out electrical work.

The holder of an electrical fitter licence must be able to, without supervision, carry out electrical work compliant with the Australian Standard AS3000 and relevant legislation. To this end the Board requires an applicant to have evidence of having achieved both the underpinning knowledge and workplace competency.

The underpinning academic knowledge is evidenced by the Registered Training Organisation. This form is to enable the employer/trainer to evidence the worker's experience of on-the-job tasks. The information is to demonstrate the breadth of experience gained.

The experience declared will be assessed and an audit may be performed if there is any doubt to its validity.

Please attach separate additional pages, if required. The person making the declaration and the witness are required to sign any additional attachments. Please clearly refer to attachments in the made declaration, should you use them.
